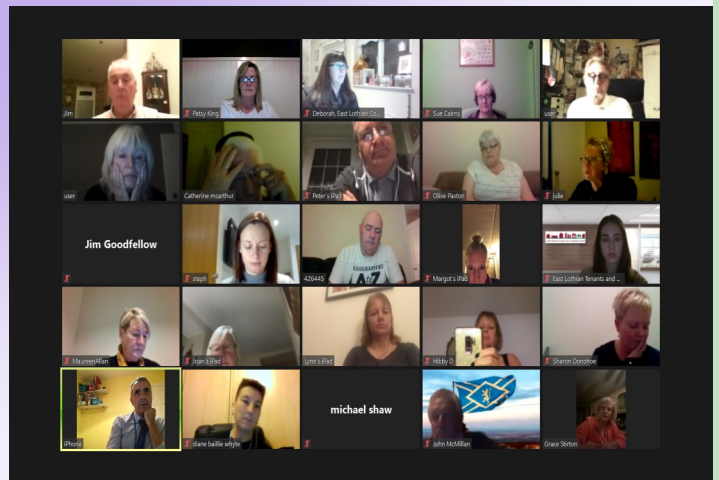
Another first for ELTRP?

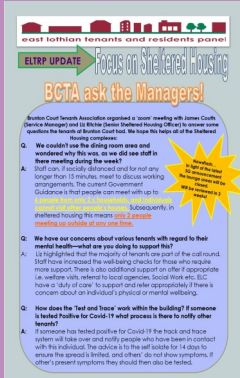

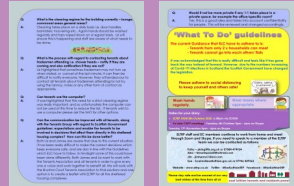
